Activities like this can enhance your relationships with the kids in your care and create lasting summer memories.



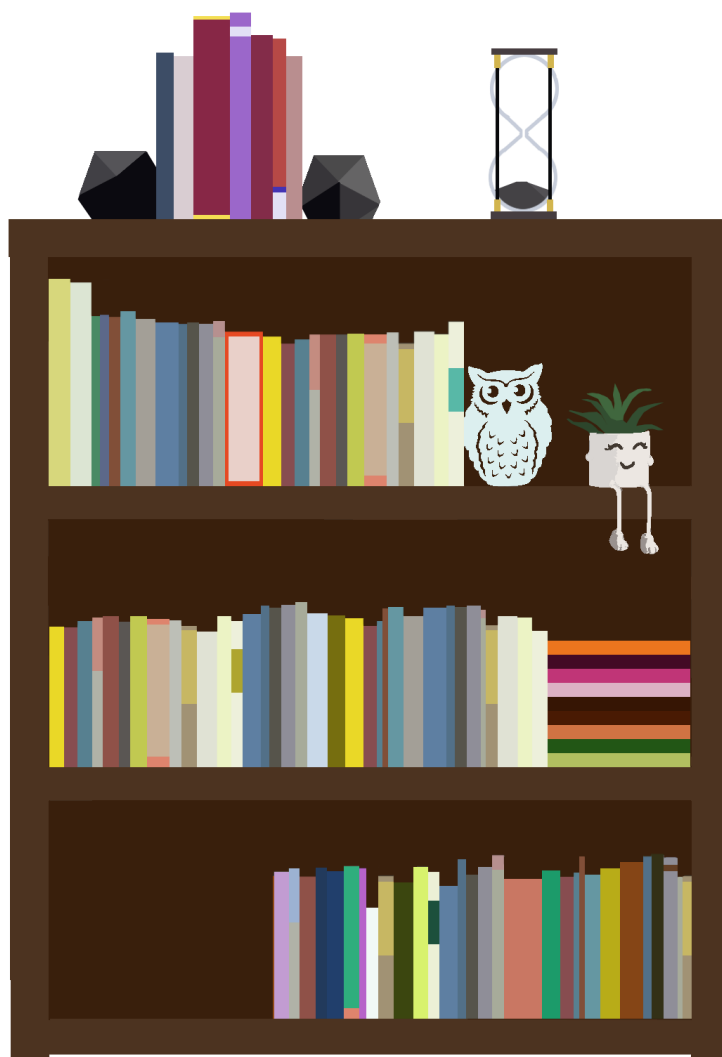

SESSION HIGHLIGHT

Trauma-informed Transition Training

July 27, 28, 29, 30

August 4, 5, 6, & 7

9:30 AM – 12:30 PM

Foster caregivers play a vital role in welcoming children and youth into and out of their homes, often during times of uncertainty and change. This training focuses on building practical, trauma-informed strategies to support transitions with care, predictability, and connection. Over eight focused sessions, each three hours in length, participants will explore and learn about: community building, relationships, The Act, trauma-informed principles, policy, advocacy, grief and loss, and apply all of these to specific scenarios.
